OJAI BASIN GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AGENCY Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of April 24, 2025

The Regular Meeting of April 24, 2025, of the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency was called to order at 3:00 PM in the Council Chambers, Ojai City Hall, 401 S. Ventura Street, Ojai, CA 93023.

4. **GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS:** Aranda reported that there has been significant work on the database. The quarterly statements were updated and mailed the last week of March. Jordan Kear had a presentation "A Short Winter or Long Summer". Kear reported the Key Well was 99.77' below ground level and there was 64,000 acre-feet in the basin.

8. ACTION ITEMS:

a. Well Verification - 1188 Carne Road:

Determine that groundwater extraction by the proposed well would not be inconsistent with any sustainable groundwater management program established in the Groundwater Sustainability Plan adopted by OBGMA for the Ojai Valley Groundwater Basin;

Determine that groundwater extraction by the proposed well would not decrease the likelihood of achieving any sustainability goal for the Basin as covered by the Plan;

Adopt Resolution No. 2025-03 Authorizing Well verification for a Proposed New Well Located Within the Boundaries of the Agency on APN 029-0-010-260, 1188 Carne Road.

The Board discussed Resolution No. 2025-03. Aranda stated that Dudek had reviewed the new well application. The extraction amount on the application was eight acre-feet per year.

Whitman motioned to approve Resolution 2025-03. Finch seconded. Resolution 2025-03 was approved unanimously.

b. Proposed Well Metering Exemption Ordinance (Ordinance No. 13)

Review draft Ordinance No. 13 and provide comments. The Board welcomes public comment and testimony regarding the proposed ordinance. After receiving public comments and testimony, the Board will set a date for a public hearing to consider adoption of the ordinance.

Aranda reported that Ordinance No. 13 is following the County of Ventura's Well Metering Exemption requirements. Ordinance No. 13 will require Well Owners to be current with their reporting and

payment and there will be a fee to apply for an exemption. Whitman moved to bring Ordinance No. 13 to be presented at a Public Meeting at the Board Meeting on May 29, 2025. Finch seconded. Resolution 2025-03 was approved unanimously for the first reading at the May 29, 2025, Board meeting.
